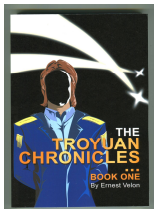

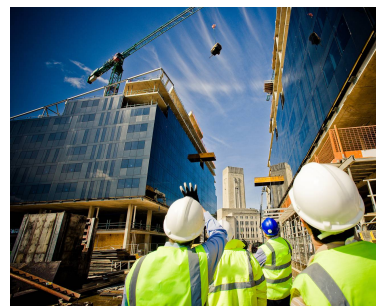
NJ State Referendum

The General Election Ballot on November 7 will ask voters to decide on the NJ Library Construction Bond Act, targeting \$125m for new construction and renovation projects

If approved, grants will be available to fund 50% of new projects - without raising local property taxes.
