

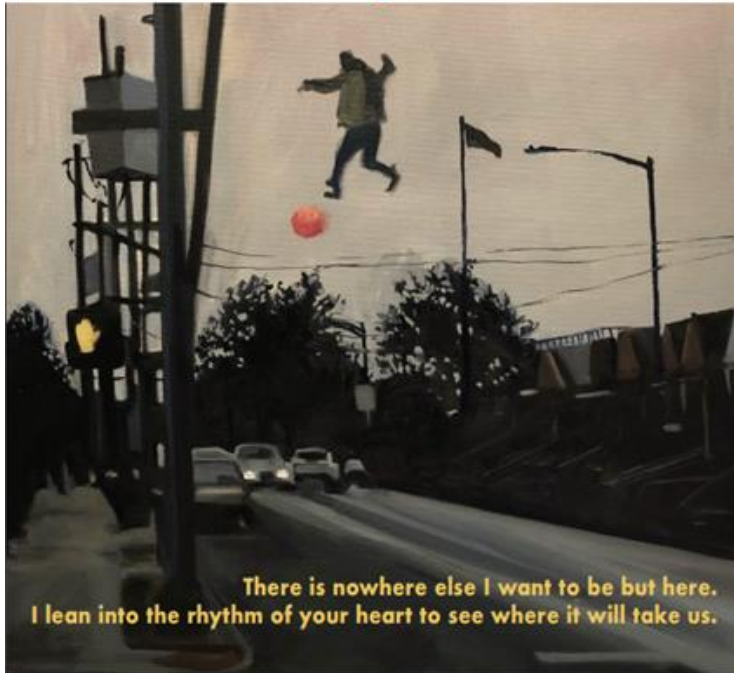


Spring 2021 Newsletter
